Guidelines for Vendors

Per the Morton Cemetery Association Rules and Regulations, prior to placing a marker, curbing or monument, permission must be obtained from the Association. Any person or business planning to do work of any nature within the cemetery grounds or upon any lots and graves shall abide by the Rules and Regulations as well as any directions from the Manager or other Executive Officer of the Association. No curbing or monument work is to be done in the cemetery on Sundays, holidays, or when a funeral is taking place. Please refer to the Rules and Regulations for complete requirements.

Customers may purchase stones and monuments from the company of their choice but the installation of markers, curbing and monuments (including all concrete work and setting of stones) must be completed by one of the following approved vendors. It is your responsibility to contact them directly regarding their prices and availability.

- Completed Work Approval Form with sketches including dimensions and inscriptions
- Marking fee of \$100.00 payable to Rick Todish

When all of the above has been approved, the space will be marked and you will be notified that work can begin.
